

Borders Youth Theatre Workshops - Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct is brought to the attention of parents/guardians.

We ask, that you and your child/young person read them carefully and support us in our efforts to ensure that we provide a safe, positive and supportive environment for young people to learn Drama skills at our Borders Youth Theatre Workshops.

- . Participants should behave in a responsible manner and are expected to do as they are asked, whilst under our care.
- . Consideration, courtesy and respect should be shown at all times to each other, Volunteers and Workshop Leaders.
- . Any form of violence towards others e.g. fighting, verbal violence (swearing, verbal bullying etc.) will lead to the parents/guardians of those involved being informed and the participant may lose their place at the Workshop.
- . Everyone should always try to understand other people's point of view.
- . Participants should always show friendship, kindness and care to others.
- . We expect all participants to respect their own and others property, including props and costume brought in by the Workshop Leaders.
- . Chewing gum, food and energy drinks are not permitted in workshops.
- . We expect all participants to make sure that the workshop space and its surroundings are kept in good condition.

We will always allow a participant to quietly sit out if they do not wish to join in with an activity, but we request that they do so in a manner that does not disrupt the Workshop.
